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## Competition rules:

According to the competition rules adapted to Hungarian Taekwondo Federation, full contact – K.O. system, i.e.:

- Children I. and Children's II age groups are prohibited from kicking the head;
- Children's III and Cadet 'B' categories are prohibited from kicking the head;
- Junior, Adult and Veteran 'B' categories are prohibited from head kicking;
- Children's III, Cadet, Junior, Adult and Veteran "A" categories are allowed to kick the head.

## Categories:

- Child I and Child II – one category (category "C")
- Child III, Cadet, Junior, Adult, Veteran – separate 'A' and 'B' categories

## Categorization:

Category 'A': 4th kup and above.  
Category 'B': 5th kup and below

## Weight-in

28.10.2022 weight-in in Budapest (place to be announced later)  
29.10.2022 at the competition venue from 7.00 to 8.30

However, weight-in on the day of the competition is possible, if the athlete is not able to produce the right weight, he or she will be disqualified. A maximum tolerance of 200g is acceptable for weighing into the weight group. After the draw, it is not possible to change weight and age groups.

**The age and weight modifications can be made on the TPSS website until 28.10.2022, before the draw.**

The draw will take place the day before the competition.



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## Age classes and weight groups:

- **Child I** (6-7 years old),  
-22, -24, -27, -30, -33, -37, +37 kg (boys and girls)
- **Child II** (8-9 years old),  
-24, -27, -30, -33, -37, -40, -44, +44 kg (boys and girls)
- **Child III** (10-11 years old),  
-30, -33, -36, -40, -44, -48, -53, +53 kg (boys and girls)
- **Cadet** (12-14 years old),  
Boys: -41, -45, -49, -53, -57, -61, +61 kg  
Girls: -37, -41, -44, -47, -51, -55, +55 kg
- **Junior** (15-17 years old)  
Boys: -48, -51, -55, -59, -63, -68, -73, +73 kg  
Girls: -44, -46, -49, -52, -55, -59, -63, +63 kg
- **Adult** (older than 17 years)  
Male -58, -68, -80, +80 kg  
Female -49, -57, -67, +67 kg
- **Veteran** – born before 1987 (over 35 years old)  
Male: -58, -68, -80, +80 kg  
Female: -49, -57, -67, +67 kg

Which age class a contestant belongs to is determined by his/her year of birth.

## Merge:

There is no merge in terms of the official result!



## Match time:

- Children's age groups I, II and III: 3 x 1 minutes, 30 second rest.
- Cadet: 3 x 1 minutes, 30 second rest.
- Junior, adult: 3 x 1.5 minutes, 30 second rest.
- Veteran: 3 x 1 minutes, 30 second rest.

## The competition will take place according to the new WT rules.

Based on the judgement of the chief judge and the competition director, changes in the round's times are possible before the competition.

## Terms and Conditions

The competition is open to athletes from other WTE member countries.

## Entry fee

The entry fee can be transferred to the account of the Hungarian Taekwondo Federation or paid in cash at the registration. On-site the entry fee payment lasts until 9:30 am.

Teams arranged in cut-off system.



- There is a separate women's and men's competition in each age class and category.
- The competition is arranged in „cut-off” system. 1-1 poomsae in preliminaries and the semifinal, 2 poomsae in the final must be performed.
- In Individual category „A”, in Junior and Adult (18+, 30+, 40+) age classes, the competition is arranged in „elimination” system. In elimination system, 1 poomsae must be performed in each round.
- In category „A” competitors must know all the possible poomsae of their category. Poomsae, which must be presented, is drawn.
- If the competitor doesn't know the poomsae drawn, no other poomsae can be presented.
- The drawing will take place the day before the competition.
- There is no drawing in category "B", the competitors are free to choose from the poomsae given for the age class.
- Which age class a contestant belongs to is determined by his/her year of birth
- In pairs and teams, category “A” a Female and a Male contestant can create a pair only and only contestants of the same sex can create a team (F/F/F or M/M/M).
- In pairs and teams, category “B” any composition, i.e. men's, women's or mixed pairs and teams are allowed to compete.
- The pair or team are ranked in age groups and categories based on the oldest competitor and the highest belt classification
- One competitor can participate in one pair and in one team only!

#### **FREESTYLE POOMSAE:**

- The individual creative, freestyle poomsae competition is held in accordance with the official WT rules.
- The result counts towards the team points competition
- Prize: medal and certificate for the I-III places
- For creative poomsae, music should be delivered on a usb drive

## **Para-Poomsae individual competition**

In accordance with our traditions, we also want to make room for our fellow athletes with disabilities, so we have included the Para-poomsae category in the program here as well.

- In this category, two freely chosen form exercises will be presented by the competitors.
- Category breakdown by classification.

## **How the competition works**

- The tournaments are held in single elimination system, by flag. In the qualifiers, semi-finals and final, 1-1 poomsae must be performed.
- Each poomsae should be presented over a time interval of 30-90 seconds. The rest time between the two poomsae is 30-60 secs.





- The referee chairman of the competition with the consent of the organizer can change the order of the category „B” at the beginning of the competition. In such case coaches must be informed on these changes.

### ATTENTION!

In any age group category, if only one competitor competes, he or she must also demonstrate the poomsae that applies to that category, only then can he or she receive a medal. **His or her result still counts towards the team competition!**

## Rapid kicking competition

### Rules:

- **Conduct of the competition:**  
The contestants follow one after the other. Each contestant can try **twice**. The result of the better one counts towards the competition. In the event of a tie, the contestants decide the medal finishes in an extra round.
- Daedo PSS electronic system is kicked in by the contestants.
- A valid result is what is entered.
- In a Daedo PSS electronic foot guard, you need to kick the protector.
- **Foot guards should be brought by everyone! There is no possibility to rent!**
- Clothing: dobok, belt
- Kicking time: 20 sec
- Between two consecutive kicks, the executing leg must touch the ground (e.g.: scissoring, snapping).
- The scoreboard is constantly visible to the contestants.
- Judge starts and stops the contestant.

### Age classes (boy, girl):

- **Children I-II** (6-9 years old),
- **Children III** (10-11 years old),
- **Cadet** (12-14 years old),
- **Junior** (15-17 years old),
- **Adult** (18-35 years old),
- **Veteran** (35+ years old)

### Prize:

- Medal and certificate for the I-III places
